- b) Which of these fairy tales did you enjoy listening to or reading?

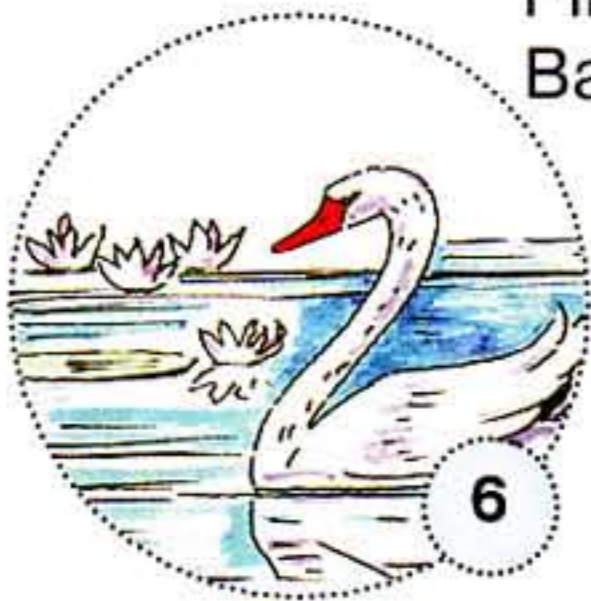
- 6 Answer these questions.
